Customizable: primary color, filter over featured image, logo

Privacy policy link compatible (footer)

Accessibility-ready

The theme

Clean

Minimal

Lightweight (web fonts, jQuery)



Development

<u>Developed</u> on GitHub until WP 5.0 (now <u>Trac</u>)

Based on <u>s</u> and <u>Gutenberg</u> starter themes

SASS

Short development cycle: <u>16 October</u> - <u>6 December 2019</u>



Compatibility with editor

Compatible with all core blocks Visually: editor = front-end



Styling

Stylesheets:

- style.css (style-rtl.css) & print.css
- style-editor.css & style-editor-customizer.css

Hooks used for styles:

- wp_enqueue_scripts
- enqueue_block_editor_assets

add_editor_style('style-editor.css')

add_theme_support('wp_block_styles')

add theme support('align-wide')

add_theme_support('editor-font-sizes' , array())

add_theme_support('editor-color-palette', array())
